The Refugee Women's Health Coach (RWHC) will provide care coordination for refugee women at risk of developing cardiovascular disease. The RWHC will assist in developing a plan of care, creating appropriate referrals for identified patients and will manage this panel of patients to increase their health outcomes and general wellness. The RWHC helps to bridge the gap between the diverse patient population they serve and the health care system. The RWHC collaborates with the patient's primary care provider, the social work and nurse case managers, other providers who are part of the treatment team and other community service providers who are engaged in the care of the patient.
