### Essential Duties

Under the supervision of the Director of Integrated Behavioral Health, the Lead Behavioral Health Clinician serves as a liaison between Behavioral Health Leadership and location clinicians and general communication with staff on behavioral health matters, including scheduling. The Lead Behavioral Health Clinician provides direct supervision to on-site Behavioral Health staff. In addition, the site Lead performs all duties as outlined in the Clinical Social Worker job description, such as rapid assessment, diagnosis, brief counseling support, and individual and group psychotherapy.

- Licensure as an independent clinical social worker in the State of Vermont.
- Licensed as an Alcohol and Drug Counselor in the state of Vermont.
