Essential Duties

Community Health Centers of Burlington is recruiting for a Registered Nurse to join our team to provide care coordination of medical and behavioral health patients receiving medication assisted therapy (MAT) for opioid addiction. Teaming with a LADC, the position provides health home services to a panel of over 100 MAT patients in coordination with prescribing buprenorphine providers and Behavioral Health clinicians at CHCB. This position will also coordinate with other treatment providers from whom patients are receiving services. As part of embedded support service, the MAT RN will provide for the planning and coordination of care and will assist with medical monitoring of patients receiving Buprenorphine treatment. The RN will also ensure that MAT patients receive other health home services.
